WHAT IS STRUCTURED WORKPLACE LEARNING (SWL)?

A short term, hands on placement for secondary students undertaking a vocational course. Students apply, and build on, the knowledge gained during their studies. Placement can be for a week block or one or two days a week for an agreed period.
