- Working safely as part of a team
- Measuring and calculating
- Using basic industry terminology to communicate effectively
- Producing simple technical drawings
- Using basic welding equipment
- Using plumbing pipes, fittings, and fixtures to simulate plumbing installations
- Read and interpret plumbing plans and specifications
- Safely select and use plumbing tools, materials and equipment
- Measure, cut, bend, and join piping systems
- Install and test fixtures such as toilets, sinks, and water tanks
- Work with roofing materials and basic sheet metal tasks
- Understand the fundamentals of gas, water, and drainage systems
- Apply workplace safety and environmental sustainability practices
