Qualification and Recognition:

- This program provides recognition of VCE VET credit. Students undertaking SHB30121 Certificate III in Beauty may accrue two or more VCE VET units of credit at Units 1 and 2 levels by completing a minimum of 180 nominal hours across multiple certificate II & III qualifications.
