Description:

Are you passionate about working with children and supporting their growth and development? This course gives you the essential skills to begin a meaningful career in early childhood education.

Students will learn relevant policies and procedures to ensure children's safety, promote inclusive practices, and begin to develop the knowledge and skills to commence an exciting career in the early childhood education and care sector.

There is a Mandatory Placement component of this course that must be completed. This program is for a partial completion of the Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care. For students who wish to complete the full qualification, you will have the option of enrolling in the remaining units beyond your secondary schooling.

You will learn things like:

- Build respectful, supportive relationships with children, families, and the community
- Guide children's behaviour using positive and age appropriate strategies
- Plan and create engaging learning environments that support development
- A range of practical early childhood skills
- Learn to facilitate children's play and leisure to help them to achieve developmentally
- Understand your responsibilities around health, safety, legal, and ethical practices
- Work as part of a professional early childhood team.

Qualification and Recognition:

- This program provides recognition of VCE VET credit. Students undertaking CHC30121 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care may be awarded a VCE VET Unit 3–4 sequence upon completing at least 180 nominal hours at AQF Level III. An ATAR increment of 10% may apply under Block Credit Recognition. Scored assessment is not available.
