### Pathway Development

LLENs are instrumental in developing clear career pathways, with over 10,000 students in School to Work placements since 2022. With many participating students transitioning to further education, training, or employment after completing their placements.

### Increased School Engagement

We support all secondary schools, contributing to a significant reduction in school disengagement through Work Based Learning, Work Experience, Workplace Tours, Practice Interviews and more!

### Workforce Readiness

LLENs focus on industry partnerships has resulted in tens of thousands of young people gaining hands-on experience in various sectors, with many securing apprenticeships or traineeships directly through LLEN initiatives.

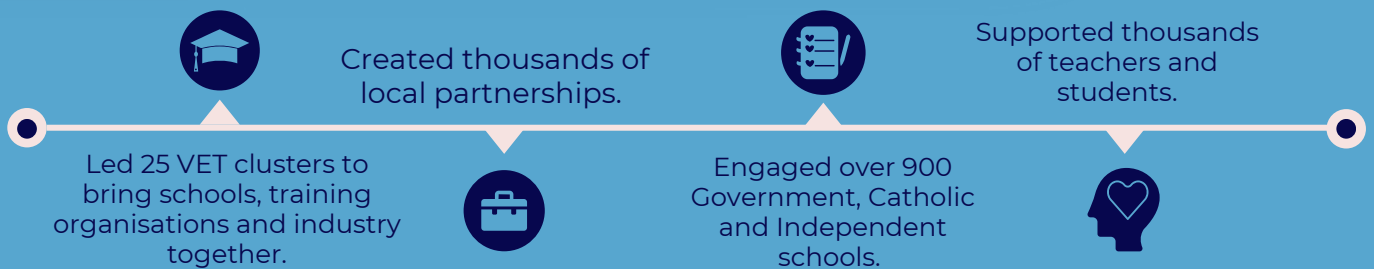
To better facilitate employment pathways LLENs also provide exposure to employers through Career and Apprenticeship Expos, Mock Interviews and Workplace Tours.
