Description:

Are you wanting to work in the commercial airline industry or as a career military pilot? This course is aimed at students who have an interest in training for a career as a pilot, using the Civil Aviation Safety Authority, Commercial Pilot Licence course, with modules taken from the AVI5022 Diploma of Aviation.

This course is very flexible and allows the student to study towards the Recreational Pilot Licence - the first stage of pilot training over two years. The course will focus on the fundamental building blocks of flying training, those aspects of a pilot skill base that are an essential foundation to the more advanced aspects of the course for those considering further qualifications in the aviation industry.

You will learn things like:

- Basic aircraft handling skills on the ground and in the air
- 10 hours dual flying experience (each year)
- Basic Aeronautical Knowledge
- Vocational opportunities and career paths in the aviation industry
- The ability to work towards a Recreation pilot Licence (first stage in a pilot's training)

- Are you between 15 - 16 years of age
- Able to pass medical examinations carried out by a Civil Aviation Safety Authority approved medical examiner to CPL standard
- Appropriate level of motivation
- Year 10 students must have the right language, literacy and numeracy standards
